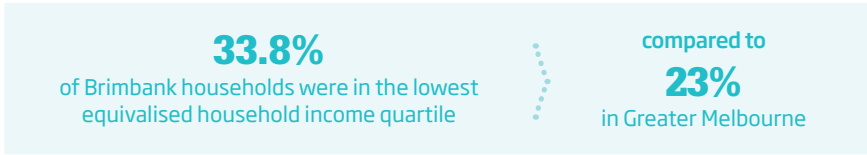

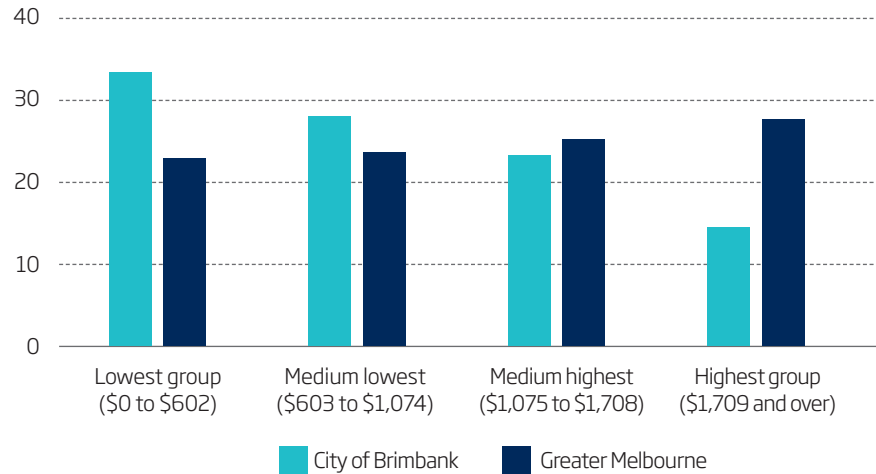
This Snapshot of Brimbank's Community provides demographic analysis of the City and its suburbs, based on second and third release data from the 2021 Census of Population and Housing.

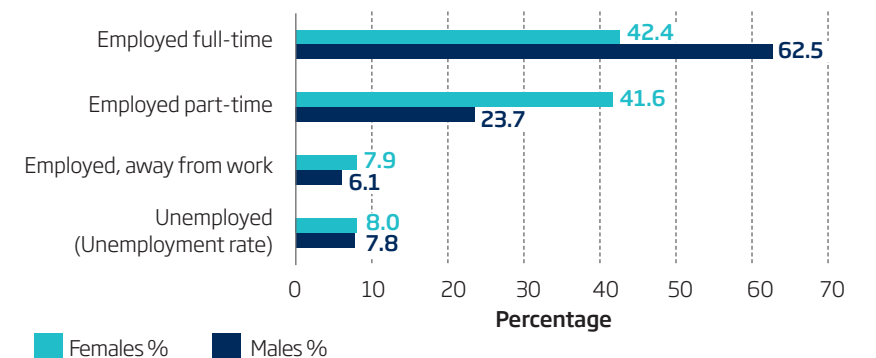


Household Income

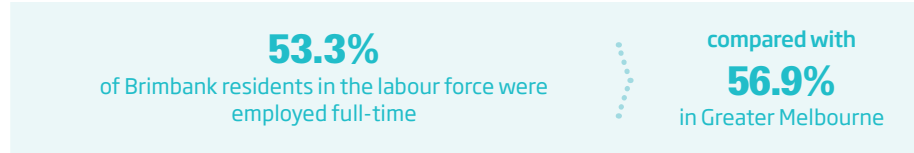
Equivalised household income quartiles 2021
